

Chemical Inventory System



Environmental Health and Safety (EH&S) is pleased to announce that the new systemwide Chemical Inventory System (CIS) is now available.

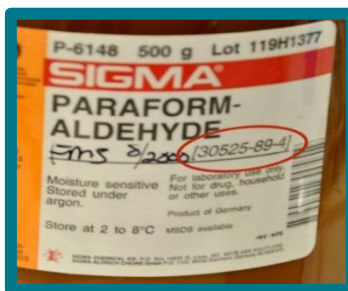
Federal and State regulations require businesses that use, handle or store hazardous chemicals to maintain an accurate hazardous chemical inventory, and electronically report hazardous materials use to enforcement agencies. UC policies and procedures require departments to input inventories into the new CIS in order to meet this regulatory requirement.

The new CIS provides enhanced features:

- Easy to use
- Multiple account Managers (no longer limited to 2)
- Access to a larger chemical library
- Create room hazard signs based on chemical inventory hazards
- Compatible with County and state chemical reporting systems
- Future integration with Information Technology programs, including a standard operating procedure library and fire safety tools.

Update inventory records

- At least annually
- Whenever new chemicals are introduced into the work area
- Whenever a chemical is completely removed from the work area



What needs to be inventoried?

All Hazardous Chemicals Including:

- All solid and liquid hazardous chemicals and mixtures
- All Compressed Gases
- Acutely Toxic Substances
- Carcinogens
- Reproductive Toxins
- Select Agents
- Perchlorate material
- Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standard (CFATS)
- Chemical of Interest (COI)

New Quantity Thresholds

All amounts of hazardous materials greater than 1mg or 1ml (with isolated exceptions) must be reported in your chemical inventory
