Why are we monitoring the air?

Construction activities can create dusty environments. EH&S wants to ensure that dust and other potential construction materials do not exceed established standards and keep you as comfortable as possible during construction.

What to expect

You may notice air monitoring pumps placed throughout hallways and corridors. Please do not disturb the sensitive equipment. These pumps make a slight humming noise that should not be disruptive.
