**LASER emitting equipment** are common devices used in research settings. Rooms where a LASER is located are identified in the “**physical hazards**” section of the room posting.

**Common equipment labels** are depicted below. Notice the various types of labels that can be used. Do not come in contact or move any equipment that is posted with these labels. If equipment needs to be moved to perform your work, contact the lab manager for guidance.



Room doors and lab areas may also have a sign that illuminates when the LASER is on. If you see this light on, **DO NOT ENTER**. Contact your supervisor for further instructions.

LASER equipment is often set up on tables surrounded by a protective safety curtain as displayed below. **NEVER** enter past these curtains without permission from the lab manager.
