

WEEKLY SAFETY TOPICS EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT USING AN EYEWASH

IF YOU GET SOMETHING IN YOUR EYES...







1. Keep your eyes closed and do not rub them.

- 2. Call for help
 - If someone is nearby, ask them to take you to the eyewash station
 - If you're alone, stay calm and carefully go to the eyewash station yourself.

3. Flush your eyes at the eyewash station:

- Turn on the water and position your eyes in the stream.
- Hold your eyelids open with your fingers and flush for 15 minutes.
- Move your eyes in all directions to help remove the contaminant.
- Ask a co-worker to help hold your eyes open if needed.

4. Seek medical attention, even if your eyes feel fine.
