

WEEKLY SAFETY TOPICS EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT USING AN EMERGENCY SHOWER

1.Call for help. If someone else is in the room, ask them to escort you to the shower. If alone, stay calm and carefully make your way to the shower.

2. Stand under the showerhead and pull the shower handle down to turn it on.

3. Wet the entire head and body and remove excess clothing. Move around to wet all areas. You may need to strip down to bare skin.

4. Flush for 15 full minutes or longer.

5. You can use the eyewash at the same time if you have splashed on your face or in the eyes.

6. Seek medical attention. Always have a medical professional check your skin and eyes, even if you feel okay. If you can, take the product safety data sheet (SDS) with you.
