



Starting January 17, 2017, UC Riverside will adopt a new systemwide tool called UC Radiation to manage radioactive material use.

This online system brings many benefits to researchers including:

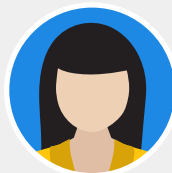
- Streamlines the RUA application and amendment process by using a web-based process
- Eliminates paper use logs by using an electronic use log
- Calculates decay of your radioactive materials automatically; no more manual calculations
- Real-time inventory eliminates the need for monthly updates

Roles



Responsible Person (RP)

This is the Principal Investigator. RPs assign the level of access for each lab/group member. RPs have full access to the system.



Delegate

These users have the same access as RPs and are able to amend an RUA on behalf of an RP.



Authorized User

All other lab/group members are AUs. They have the ability to request, document and dispose of radioactive material.

Accessing the System

PIs and researchers working with, or who plan to work with, radioactive material or radiation-producing machines can access the system by going to ehs.ucop.edu/radiation and signing in using their UCR single sign on credentials.

Researchers currently working with radioactive material under an approved Radiation Use Authorization, or RUA, will notice upon log in that their data has been pre-loaded into the system and they have the proper access to complete necessary functions.
